Thanks to the generosity of landowners like you and the dedication of our volunteer staff, we currently hold conservation easements and own fee properties totaling over 400 acres.

During my visit on , I performed a visual inspection to monitor the activities on your property as they pertain to the terms of your conservation easement. This letter will serve as a record that my monitoring did not reveal any activities that conflict with the terms of your easement. Abby Brooks, SPA President, or Heather Steers, Stewardship Committee Chair, would be most willing to discuss the details of your easement with you. In addition, please feel free to contact SPA about any land management issues relevant to your conserved land.
