

Olneyville Health Equity Zone









# Pawtucket Central Falls Resiliency Planning

#### Who Created the survey?



**178 Surveys Collected** 122 in English 56 in Spanish

- Email campaign
- In person interviews

Physical interviews were collected from BVCAP and Progreso Latino

Flooding: 116 somewhat-extremely concerned 23 not concerned

Lack of Parks and Open space: 130 somewhat to extremely concerned 38 not concerned

Limited Access to Healthy Food: 137 Somewhat-Extremely Concerned 32 not concerned

Lack of Trees: 144 Somewhat-Extremely Concerned 25 not concerned

When asked what climate resiliency strategies people would like to see in your city?

84 High priority: More opportunities to grow your own food/buy locally grown food

107 High Priority: More plants, trees

116 High Priority: Increase opportunities to reduce waste, prevent litter, recycle, compost





Has to look good and be maintained to gain community support

Know the context of your project location, who will be maintaining GI, public or private land

Aggregate resources to bring to municipalities, businesses, and residents

In lieu of stormwater utility engage individual property owners based on interest (and ability to pay)
